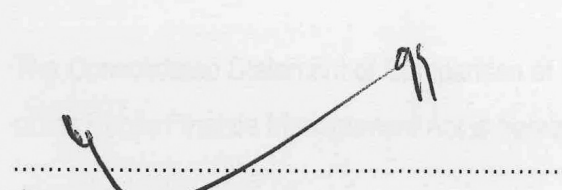
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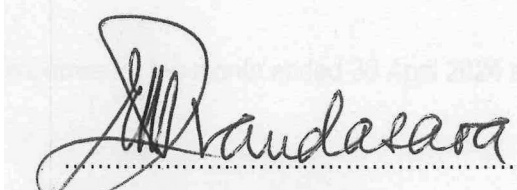
## SECRETARY AND PAYMASTER GENERAL'S APPROVAL

## ACCOUNTANT GENERAL'S REVIEW

### Mandate

Section 38 of the Public Finance Management Act [*Chapter 22:19*] requires Treasury to publish consolidated financial reports in the *Gazette* within thirty days after the end of each month. This financial statement shows how the budget for the financial year 2024 which was presented to Parliament by the Minister of Finance and Economic Development on 30 November 2023 has been executed. This Statement of Comparison of Budget and Actual Amounts covers the period ended 30 November 2024. The statement only relates to Government entities listed on page 10 of the 2024 Estimates of Expenditure (Blue book), other extra-budgetary units such as state universities, and funds created in accordance with section 302(a) and (b) of The Constitution of Zimbabwe are excluded.

The budget and accounting are on a cash basis and this statement is compiled using the cash basis.

The Consolidated Statement of Comparison of Budget and Actual Amounts for the Government of Zimbabwe for the month ended 30 November 2024 as required by section 38 of the Public Finance Management Act is hereby presented.

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**NOTE DISCLOSURES FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF ZIMBABWE FOR THE MONTH ENDED 30 November 2024****TOTAL REVENUE**

For November 2024, total revenue reached ZWG 17.98 billion, exceeding the budgeted figure of ZWG 11.14 billion by 62.44%. The devaluation of the Zimbabwe Gold (ZWG) by 44% against the US dollar at the end of September 2024 has played a key role in inflating revenue collected in foreign currency terms when converted to ZWG. Year-to-date, total revenue stood at ZWG 97.43 billion, exceeding the budget by 14.02%.

**TOTAL EXPENDITURE**

Total expenditure for November 2024 amounted to ZWG 13.80 billion, surpassing the budgeted level of ZWG 9.63 billion by 43.34%. The sharp devaluation of the ZWG has increased the cost of expenditures denominated in foreign currencies, distorting budget performance. Year-to-date total expenditure reached ZWG 94.46 billion – 13.80% above the budget – reflecting ongoing fiscal pressures amid broader economic challenges.

The sharp revenue and expenditure increases reflect the fiscal pressures resulting from the devaluation of the Zimbabwe Gold (ZWG), which is distorting the budget's performance.
