

Harare (Incorporated and Local Government Areas) (Water Charges)  
(Amendment) By-laws, 2022 (No. 26)

---

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Local Government and Public Works has, in terms of section 229 of the Urban Councils Act [*Chapter 29:15*], approved the following by-laws made by the City Council of Harare: —

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Harare (Incorporated and Local Government Areas) (Water Charges) (Amendment) By-laws, 2022 (No. 26).

2. Section 4 of the Harare (Incorporated and Local Government Areas) (Water Charges) By-laws, 1981, published in Statutory Instrument 798 of 1981 (hereinafter called “the principal by-laws”), is amended in subsection (3) by the deletion of ZWL\$153,00, per cubic metre for the first five cubic metres”, and the substitution of “USD1,66,00 or equivalent of Zimbabwe local currency, per cubic metre for the first cubic metres”.

3. Section 5 of the principal by-laws is amended by the deletion of “ZWL\$115,00, per cubic metre for the first five cubic metres”, and the substitution of “USD1,24, or equivalent of Zimbabwe local currency, for the first five cubic metres”.

4. The Second Schedule to the principal by-laws is repealed and substituted by the following —
