

Harare (Incorporated and Local Government Areas) (Waste Management) (Amendment) By-laws, 2022 (No. 29)

---

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Local Government and Public Works has, in terms of section 229 of the Urban Councils Act [Chapter 29:15], approved the following by-laws made by the City Council of Harare:—

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Harare (Incorporated and Local Government Areas) (Waste Management) (Amendment) By-laws, 2022 (No. 29).

2. Part 1 of the Schedule to the Harare (Incorporated and Local Government Areas) (Waste Management) By-laws, 1981, published in Statutory Instrument 559 of 1981, is repealed and the following is substituted—

“PART 1

1. For the supply of a service in terms of section 4(1), for the regular removal and disposal of domestic waste, except where the service is supplied to council-owned premises the rental of which is fixed by the Harare (Incorporated and Local Government Area) By-laws, 1981, the following charges in United States Dollar shall be paid—

(a) for the supply of a service for the regular removal and disposal of domestic waste, the following monthly charges per bin in respect of each residential unit in Low density areas including each flat in a block.—

*with effect from 1st January, 2022*

**Low density**

Refuse collection fee, per month . . . . . USD11,00

Charitable organisations, churches and other non-profit making organisations will be classified as domestic consumers and consequently, will be levied at prevailing domestic rates;

(b) for the supply of a service for the regular removal and disposal of domestic waste, the following monthly charges per bin in respect of each residential unit in High Density Areas including each flat in a block—

*with effect from 1st January 2022*

**High density**

Refuse Collection fee, per month . . . . . USD8,00

(c) for the supply of a service for the regular removal and disposal of Industrial waste, the following are the monthly charges per bin—
